

Guest Rules Sheet

TCC welcomes you to our campgrounds and hope that you have a great time enjoying our little slice of paradise. Before your stay, we ask that you read and understand the By-law rules that are in place not only for our guest, but our members as well. The same rules apply to both. Below will be a bulleted cheat sheet of some of the most important rules and commonly asked questions. Remember that your stay can not exceed more than 14 consecutive days. The Guest that will be in charge must be 21 years of age. **A Guest may not invite other guest while on their stay that are not registered prior to their stay!** Please keep in mind that our lots are very close to one another and will have neighbors on both sides of you and possibly in the front and back. **Be respectful and courteous.** If you will be using a golf cart, please read the rules pertaining to them so that you remain in compliance with the City of Galveston and TXDOT. They can be found on our website and through the City of Galveston. If there are any questions, ask one of your neighbors in that they may be helpful, contact the Safety and Security Director, or any board member listed below. We hope that you enjoy your stay. Come back and visit us again soon!

- **Vehicles:** Speed Limit Does **NOT EXCEED** 10 mph. Please keep all vehicles parked in your designated lot. Do not park on the side of the road unless you are in your designated lot not blocking traffic. On the North End, no cars are allowed to park in the middle grass area as there are active lines buried underneath. On the South End, no parking on the side of the Pool area whatsoever. You may park in the median that's located in the center of the South End. Keep in mind that this is to make sure we do not block or alter traffic coming through and most importantly for passage of Emergency Vehicles. **NO VEHICLES ON THE BEACH!!**
- **Golf Carts:** TCC is in compliance with the City of Galveston City Ordinance Transportation Code when it comes to having and driving a golf cart. If you bring your own, you must go to the link provided on the website and read the rules per the City. If the lot you are staying on has a golf cart already and you are using it, then the rules are simplified as follows: **Must have a valid driver's license and proof of Insurance to DRIVE.** Speed Limit Does **NOT EXCEED** 10 mph. Parking will be the same rules as above. They cannot be driven on the Main Street, FM 3005, **ONLY** for crossing purposes. **No Golf Carts on the Beach!** Operating a golf cart on a beach is **Limited to Handicapped Individuals ONLY** and must clearly have a displayed placards. No driving on the beach to off load or load up at any time. Disobeying of these rules can lead to tickets, fines, and/or removal of the Campgrounds.
- **Pool Rules:** To gain access, one must have a Pool Key that's provided to all Members. Hours of Enjoyment are between 10 A.M. and 10 P.M. It is closed on Mondays. **NO Pets** allowed in or around the pool area. No Glass Containers allowed in or around the area. Bathrooms are provided for both at the fieldhouse for changing and showering. Please

treat this area with courtesy, respect, along with proper hygiene as this is highly used by all members and guest. Failure to following this rule can result up to removal from TCC.

- **Mary Hobbs Pavilion:** The first level can be openly used by any who wish to use it unless it is reserved. Failure to clean up your mess can result up to removal from TCC. Bathrooms are located upstairs and can only be opened by using your designated Pool Key. Please treat this area with courtesy, respect, along with proper hygiene as this is commonly used by all members and guest.
- **Music:** Please keep all music at a respectable level. Remember that our lots are small and that you may have neighbors at all four corners around you. After 10 p.m., the level of music needs to be turned down further so that it does not disrupt neighbors or others close to you.
- **Activity Pad:** Enjoy playing some Basketball, Volleyball and Horseshoes. Must bring your own material to play as none is provided. This area closes at 10 p.m. daily.
- **Bar-b-que:** Please be sure that the coals are extinguished before your exit of the Campgrounds. The coals are to remain in their approved container until they are completely extinguished and ready to be discarded in the trash. At no time may you dump coals in your yard or any area on the ground surface to water down. You will be held liable for any damage from careless acts.
- **Bonfires:** NO Fires of any sort are permitted to be on the beach or on a lot. The **ONLY EXCEPTION** is if it's in an approved container. **Ex:** Pit and/or Fire Ring. Digging a hole, using a barrel, etc. is **NOT APPROVED!!**

We thank you for reading, understanding and obeying our rules that are in place for ALL to follow. Again, these are just a few of the most commonly asked questions.
